Students who miss a rehearsal for any reason other than Illness or Family Emergency will be removed from the group immediately. Students who miss more than one rehearsal due to Illness or Family Emergency may be asked not to play the concert, depending on the amount of rehearsal missed. Excused absences must be verified by a doctor’s note or school absence/readmit slip for the day of or the day after the missed rehearsal. Students who are tardy to a rehearsal may be moved to the back of their section for remaining rehearsals and the concert; students with multiple tardies will be removed from the group.

Appeal: Students who have a school related conflict with one rehearsal may use the back of this page to describe the conflict and identify the sponsoring teacher of the conflicting event. If an agreement can be reached by the two teachers, the student may be excused from part or all of one rehearsal. If the two teachers cannot come to an agreement, the student must make a choice between the two events. Appeals are due at the time of application; last minute appeals will not be accepted.

- Pay \$5 fee to cover snacks at rehearsals and dinner Friday. Cash or checks payable to BHS Orchestra.**
Submit payment to your director at or before the first rehearsal; Tuesday, April 9 2013
- Have music learned a day before the guest conductor’s first rehearsal.**
Students who do not have their music learned a day before the guest conductor’s first rehearsal may be removed from the group.
- Wear the following concert attire at all performances.**
WOMEN: All black, ankle-length dress with sleeves—OR— ankle-length skirt/dress pants and black blouse with sleeves.
Black dress shoes and hose.
MEN: Tuxedo: White Tux Shirt, black tux jacket, pants, cummerbund, bow tie, black dress socks and shoes.
